**Board members William Lepore and Herbert Joslin are not present for today's meeting. Mr. Davies called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.**

**There are four (4) appeal hearings scheduled for today for which there is a board stenographer.**

**1. Barlo Signs – Violation # 2275**

**2. Robert Cheney – Violation # 2276**

### **3. Keith Durocher – Violation # 2277**

**The first three violations today are with regard to Barlo Signs. Mr. David Holbrook of Barlo Signs is here today representing the company and Mr. Cheney and Mr. Durocher.**

**Mr. Dusablon read the violations: Violation #1 – It is alleged that on February 7, 2005, Mr. Robert Gaj, RIDLT Investigator found two (2) alleged employees (Robert Cheney and Keith Durocher) of Mr. David Holbrook of Barlo Sign Company, performing electrical work at the Verizon Wireless Store, 371 Putnam Pike, Smithfield, RI without valid RI electrical licenses. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2 “work for which a license is required” (2 Violations). Violation #2 – It is alleged that on February 7, 2005, Mr. Robert Gaj, RIDLT Investigator found Robert Cheney, an alleged employee of Mr. David Holbrook of Barlo Sign Company, performing electrical work at the Verizon Store, 371 Putnam Pike, Smithfield, RI without a valid RI electrical license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2 “work for which a license is required”. Violation #3 – It is alleged that on February 7, 2005, Mr. Robert Gaj, RIDLT Investigator found Keith A. Durocher, an alleged employee of Mr. David Holbrook of Barlo Sign Company, performing electrical work at the Verizon Store, 371 Putnam Pike, Smithfield, RI without a valid RI electrical license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2 “work for which a license is required”.**

**Based on the testimony and evidence provided to the board today,**

**Mr. Marsella made a motion to uphold Violation #1, Violation #2 and Violation #3. Mr. Benell seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.**

#### **4. George Davos – Violation # 2208**

**The final appeal today is with regard to Mr. George Davos who is present and sworn in by the stenographer.**

**Mr. Dusablon read the violation: It is alleged that on November 30, 2004, Mr. George Davos, under the supervision of Mr. Louis Petrucci of Interstate Electrical Service, performed electrical work at the Joseph A. Banks Store, Smithfield Commons, Route 44, Smithfield, RI without a valid RI electrical license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2 “work for which a license is required”.**

**Based on the testimony provided today, Mr. Durand made a motion to uphold the violation. Mr. Benell seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.**

**There was no further business before the Board.**

**Mr. Davies asked the board members if they had reviewed the minutes of the February 15, 2004 meeting. Mr. Benell made a motion to accept the minutes as recorded. Mr. Racine seconded the motion.**

## **Other Business**

**Mr. Jim Barnard is present today to address the board concerning licensing for Lightning Protection Grounding Systems. Mr. Dave Cenci and Mr. Dave Reilly, City of Providence Electrical inspectors were present and express the need for an electrical permit to perform this work. The board informed Mr. Barnard that a RI licensed Electrical Contractor would be required to obtain a permit from the City of Providence and a RI licensed electrician must install lightning protection systems under RIGL 5-6-2.**

**Mr. Marsella made a motion to adjourn at 10:55 pm. Mr. Benell seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.**
