**Board members Allen Durand, Stanley Davies and Herbert Joslin are not present for today's meeting. Mr. Lepore called the meeting to order at 9:40 a.m.**

**Mr. Lepore asked the board members if they had reviewed the minutes of the March 16, 2005 meeting. Mr. Racine made a motion to accept the minutes as recorded. Mr. Benell seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.**

**There are six (6) appeal hearings scheduled for today for which there is a board stenographer.**

- 1. Robert Dessaint – Violation # 2269**
- 2. Colin Black – Violation # 2270**
- 3. Michael Hinsepp – Violation # 2271**

**The first three violations today are with regard to Dessaint Electric. Mr. Robert Dessaint, Mr. Colin Black and Mr. Michael Hinsepp of Dessaint Electric are present today as well as RIDLT Investigator Glenn Dusablon and are sworn in by the board stenographer.**

**Mr. Dusablon read the violations: Violation #1 – It is alleged that on February 4, 2005, Mr. Glenn Dusablon, RIDLT Investigator found two (2) alleged employees (Colin S. Black, Apprentice # 17417 and Michael Hinsepp) of Mr. Robert Dessaint performing electrical work at the Filenes’s Store, Route 2 Warwick Mall, Warwick, RI without valid RI electrical licenses. Violation #2 – It is alleged that on February 4, 2005, Mr. Glenn Dusablon, RIDLT Investigator, found Colin S. Black, RI Apprentice # 17417, an alleged employee of Mr. Robert Dessaint performing electrical work at the Filenes’s Store, Route 2 Warwick Mall, Warwick, RI without a valid RI electrical license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2 “work for which a license is required”. Violation #3: It is alleged that on February 4, 2005, Mr. Glenn Dusablon, RIDLT Investigator found Michael Hinsepp, an alleged**

**employee of Mr. Robert Dessaint performing electrical work at the Filenes's Store, Route 2 Warwick Mall, Warwick, RI without a valid RI electrical license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2 "work for which a license is required".**

**Based on the testimony and evidence provided to the board today, Mr. Marsella made a motion to uphold Violation #1 and to suspend for a 12-month period, Violation #2 and Violation #3. Mr. Racine seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.**

**4 - 6. Northeast Lightning Protection Systems Inc. – Violation #'s 2323, 2324, 2325**

**The appeals referenced above have been postponed until the May meeting.**

**This concludes the hearings.**

### **Other Business**

**Mr. Dusablon informed the Board of another request he has received to establish a D License for fire alarm electricians. Mr. Dusablon again referred to the law that states the non-manufacturer must have a licensed Journeyman Electrician within the organization to qualify for a D License.**

**Mr. Racine made a motion to adjourn at 10:15 pm. Mr. Benell seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.**
