Mr. Lepore called to meeting to order at 9:40 a.m. There was a Quorum.

Mr. Lepore asked if the Board had reviewed the minutes from the May 16, 2007 meeting and asked if there were any comments in regard to the minutes. Mr. Joslin stated that there were two changes to be made to page 2 of the minutes. Elaine Heiss will correct the changes

to the minutes.

There were two hearings scheduled for today. Mr. John Vendetti/Ace Electric #3157 and Mr. Robert Kallejian #3124.

RIDLT Chief Electrical Investigator, Mr. Glenn Dusablon, Mr. Vendetti and Mr. Kallejian, along with Fred Bassi, Electrical Inspector of the City of Providence. All were sworn in by the Board stenographer.

Glenn Dusablon reported that Bernard Renzi/DBA Canal Electric #3158 and Freddy Figueroa #3159 hearings have been postponed until our July meeting.

Mr. Frank Bennell, Jr., a member of the Rhode Island State Board of Examiners of Electricians hereby under oath deposes (refuse from participating in the discussion of or voting on said matter).

1. John Vendetti/DBA Ace Electric - #3157

Glenn Dusablon read the violation to the Board:

Violation: On April 10, 2007, RIDLT Chief Electrical Inspector, Glenn Dusablon, received a call from Mr. Fred Bassi, Electrical Inspector for the City of Providence. Mr. Bassi witnessed two (2) employees (Alberto Ramirez and Gilberto Garcia) of Ace Electric, P. O. Box 9562, Providence, RI 02940, performing electrical work at 236 Broadway

Street, Providence, RI without a Rhode Island electrical license. This is two (2) violations of RIGL 5-6-2 "Work for which a license is required".

Mr. Vendetti did not obtain an electrical permit with the City of Providence. This is one (1) violation of RIGL 5-6-25 "Compliance with rules and regulations of state, city or town".

This is Mr. Vendetti's second, third, and fourth violations at \$950.00 each for a total of \$2,850.

Mr. Stanley Davies made a motion that the Board go into Executive Session for further discussion on Mr. Vendetti. Mr. Herbert Joslin seconded the motion.

Board resumed the Board meeting after discussion at the Executive Session.

Stanley Davies made a motion that a finding of fact did occur and that we uphold the violation. Mr. Vendetti had no permit on the job at the time the work was performed, (he got a permit with the City of

Providence the next morning after he paid a fine of \$150.00), and he also had two unlicensed people performing work without a Rhode Island electrical license (one of them being an apprentice without supervision). Herbert Joslin seconded the motion. All board members were in favor.

Stanley Davies made a motion to uphold the fine of \$2,850 as stated in the violation, since this is Mr. Vendetti's second, third and fourth violation. Keith Burlingame seconded the motion. All Board members were in favor. Mr. Vendetti will be receiving a letter of recommendation from the Director of same, and if he decides to pay the amount in full, he will contact Ronald D'Ambruoso.

2. Robert Kallejian - #3124

Glenn Dusablon read the violation to the Board:

Violation: On March 26, 2007, RIDLT Chief Electrical Investigator, Glenn Dusablon witnessed Mr. Robert Kallejian, an employee of Mr. Donald King (DBA Rycor Services, Inc.) performing electrical work at Landmark Medical Hospital, 115 Case Avenue, Woonsocket, RI without a Rhode Island Electrical license. The electrical work being performed involved the installation of a new fire alarm system for the hospital. This is one (1) violation of RIGL 5-6-2 "Work for which a license is required".

Mr. Keith Burlingame made a motion that a finding of fact in violation of RIGL 5-6-2 did occur. Mr. Stanley Davies seconded the motion. All Board members were in favor.

Stanley Davies made a motion to suspend the violation fee of \$500 for one year, pending any further violations. Herbert Joslin seconded the motion. All Board members were in favor. Mr. Kallejian was advised that he would be receiving a recommendation for the Director in writing.
