**Mr. Lepore called to meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. There was a Quorum.**

**Mr. Lepore asked if the Board had reviewed the minutes from the previous of June 20, 2007 meeting and asked if there were any comments in regard to the minutes. Stanley Davies made a motion to accept the minutes. Frank Benell seconded the motion.**

**There were three hearings scheduled for today. Glenn Dusablon**

reported and passed out to the Board a letter from Stephen M. Litwin, Esquire for Canal Electric, Violation No. 3158, and Freddy Figueroa, Violation No. 3159, regarding the resolution of Violation No. 3158, and Violation No. 3159, which was paid in full and final resolution of both the Bernard Renzi (DBA Canal Electric), and Freddy Figueroa matters therefore withdrawing from the appeal hearing and has paid the fines.

The next hearing was pertaining to:

**1. Anthony Salvato #3267**

RIDLT Chief Electrical Investigator, Mr. Glenn Dusablon, and Mr. John Salvato were sworn in by the Board Stenographer.

Glenn Dusablon read the violation to the Board: Violation No. 3267 for Anthony Salvato, dated August 17, 2007.

Violation: RIGL 5-6-23 “Certificates not transferable-Suspension or revocation of certificates. No certificates issued under this chapter shall be assignable or transferable.”

Glenn F. Dusablon, RIDLT Chief Electrical Investigator, received a complaint from property owner Melissa Baker (DBA Reservoir Ventures), 1 Richmond Square, Providence, RI. Ms. Baker informed me she had contracted electrical work with a Christopher M. Marchetti and she wanted to file a complaint with the Department. Further

**investigation and confirmation with David Cenci, Chief Electrical Inspector for the City of Providence, showed Anthony Salvato (A-003364) as the electrical permit holder for the property. Ms. Baker contracted the electrical work with Christopher M. Marchetti and she has never contracted electrical work, met or given money to Mr. Anthony Salvato.**

**This is one (1) violation of RIGL 5-6-23 and this law requires a hearing and recommendation by the Board of Examiners of Electricians to the Director of Labor and Training to suspend or revoke a certificate.**

**A revocation of license hearing will be held at the RI Department of Labor and Training, Building 70, 2nd Floor Conference Room on September 19, 2007 at 9:30 am. Your attendance is required. Failure to appear will result in automatic revocation of license.**

**Mr. Salvato was brought before the Board for questioning. Mr. Salvato said that Mr. Chris Marchetti contacted him to do some work. Mr. Salvato also stated that pulled a permit for the work done on the property and also wired and installed smoke detectors. Glenn Dusablon reported to the Board that Melissa Baker hired Mr. Marchetti to do the work, but the work was never completed. Mr. Marchetti was contracting work without a contracting license, and both Mr. Marchetti and his lawyer admitted that Mr. Marchetti was**

**guilty, but still has not paid the fine.**

**Allen Durand motioned to go into Executive Session, and Frank Benell seconded the motion.**

**Allen Durand motioned to move back into the Board meeting, Herbert Joslin seconded the motion.**

**Allen Durand made a motion that a finding of fact had occurred based on information that Mr. Salvato pulled a permit for someone else, was warned about this before, since he pulled permits for two other unlicensed people, Mr. Rodrigues and Mr. Marchetti, and Mr. Salvato has had three previous violations to this violation, and has transferred his license to someone else to do work under his license. Allen Durand motioned to have Mr. Salvato's license be suspended for one year, and Mr. Salvato can still practice under his License B (Journeyman's license) and can work for someone else. Mr. Herbert Joslin seconded the motion. William Lepore, Chair was told that he will receive a recommendation (notice) from the Director.**

**New Business:**

**Allen Durand made a motion to have a letter sent to Ron Racine for all of his hard work and dedication to the Board. Stanley Davies seconded the motion.**

**Discussion was made regarding the Telecommunications Laws.**

**Keith Burlingame made a motion to adjourn. Allen Durand seconded the motion. All board members were in favor.**
