**Meeting was called to order at 9:45 am by Stanley Davies.**

**Stanley Davies asked to dispense with the minutes from last meeting.**

**HEARING:**

**Keith Burlingame, Board Member, recused himself from the hearing.**

**1. Custom Systems (AAA Alarms), Joseph Trillo**

**Appeal hearing on violation # 3311, Joseph Trillo, Custom Systems (AAA Alarms). Mr. Trillo is in attendance representing himself. Also in attendance are Westerly Fire Chief, David Sayles and Glenn**

**Dusablon, Electrical Investigator. The stenographer swears in all parties.**

**Glenn Dusablon read the violation to the Board.**

**VIOLATIONS: 1. On September 21, 2007, Westerly Fire Chief, David Sayles filed a complaint with the Department of Labor and Training after witnessing an electrical fire alarm installation being installed by two unlicensed employees of Joseph M. Trillo, Custom Systems (AAA Alarms), 798 Providence Street, West Warwick, RI. Fire Chief Sayles witnessed the unlicensed employees (Randy Parr, App.#9015 and Woody Pierre, App.#9063) installing an electrical fire alarm system at 105 White Rock Road, Westerly on two consecutive days, Thursday, September 20, 2007 and Friday, September 21, 2007 without Rhode Island Fire Alarm Installer's Licenses. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2-"work for which a license is required".**

**2. On September 21, 2007, Westerly Fire Chief, David Sayles filed a complaint to the Department of Labor & Training after witnessing an electrical fire alarm installation being installed by Woody Pierre, and employee of Joseph M. Trillo/Custom Systems (AAA Alarms). Mr.**

**Pierre performed this work on two consecutive days, Thursday, September 20, 2007 and Friday, September 21, 2007 at 105 White Rock Road, Westerly, RI without a Rhode Island Fire Alarm Installer's license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2-"work for which a license is required".**

**3. On September 21, 2007, Westerly Fire Chief, David Sayles filed a complaint to the Department of Labor & Training after witnessing an electrical fire alarm installation being installed by Randy Parr, and employee of Joseph M. Trillo/Custom Systems (AAA Alarms). Fire Chief Sayles witnessed the unlicensed employee, Randy Parr, App#9015, installing an electrical fire alarm system on two consecutive days, Thursday, September 20, 2007 and Friday, September 21, 2007 at 105 White Rock Road, Westerly, RI without a Rhode Island Fire Alarm Installer's license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2-"work for which a license is required".**

**A motion to go into executive session was made by Al Durand and seconded by Frank Benell.**

**The Board went into executive session.**

**A motion for the Board to remove itself from executive session was made by Al Durand and seconded by Frank Benell.**

**Viol # 3311-Al Durand made a motion to the fact that the violation did**

**occur; this was seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the Board.**

**Al Durand made a motion to recommend to the Director that the fine of \$1000.00 be imposed as written, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the Board.**

**Viol #3321-Al Durand made a motion to the fact that the violation did occur, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the Board.**

**Al Durand made a motion to recommend to the Director that the fine of \$500.00 be imposed as written, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the Board.**

**Viol #3322-Al Durand made a motion to the fact that the violation did occur, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the Board.**

**Al Durand made a motion to recommend to the Director that the fine of \$500.00 be imposed as written, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the Board.**
