Reilly Electrical Contractors Inc. violation #'s 2534, 2546, 2547, 2458, & 2549.

All parties are sworn in. Ted Radway, attorney representing the Director of Labor gave the board an overview of the travel of the case which is currently pending appeal to the Superior Court. Mr. Radway presented the transcript from the March 15, 2006 board meeting for the board to review.

Atty. Girard Visconti who represents Relco Inc. addressed the board and asked if the transcript from 3/15/06 could be entered as an exhibit.

Violation #2534-Michael McSheffrey, Relco Inc.-(1) violation of RIGL 5-6-25-“compliance with rules and regulations of state, city, or town”, in the amount of \$950.00, a motion was made by Bob Zuba to dismiss this violation, seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board.

Violation #2546-Michael McSheffrey, Relco Inc.-(1) violation of RIGL

5-6-25-“compliance with rules and regulations of state, city or town”, (3) violations of RIGL-5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”, a total of (4) violations in the amount of \$3800.00. A motion was made by Bob Zuba that this violation stands as is, seconded by Keith Burlingame, passed unanimously by the board. A motion was made by Bob Zuba that the fine of \$3800.00 be assessed seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board.

Violation #2547-Rob Rutledge, Relco Inc.-(1) violation of RIGL 5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”, for a fine of \$500.00. A motion was made by Bob Zuba that this violation stands as is, seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board. A motion was made by Bob Zuba that the fine of \$500.00 be assessed, seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board.

Violation #2548-John Brewer, Relco Inc.-(1) violation of RIGL 5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”, for a fine of \$500.00. A motion was made by Bob Zuba that this violation stands as is, seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board. A motion was made by Bob Zuba that the fine of \$500.00 be assessed, seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board.

Violation #2549-Ray Bombardier, Relco Inc.-(1) violation of RIGL 5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”, for a fine of \$500.00. A motion was made by Bob Zuba that this violation stands as is, seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board.

A motion was made by Bob Zuba that the fine of \$500.00 be assessed, seconded by Frank Benell, passed unanimously by the board.

These are recommendations of the board to the Director of Labor & Training.

A motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting was made by Frank Benell and seconded by Bob Zuba. Passed unanimously by the board.
