**Meeting was called to order at 9:40 am by William Lepore**

**A motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting was made by Frank Benell and seconded by Stanley Davies. Passed unanimously by the board**

**Hearings: Eugene Iovine-violation#'s 3472, 3473, 3474, 3475, 3476, 3477 and 3478-**

**Ben Copple, Legal addressed the board, he and Glenn Dusablon met with Mr. Iovine's Attorney and discussed the violations. There were six (6) witnesses scheduled to testify against Mr. Iovine. The**

violations against Mr. Iovine are no license and no permit. At the meeting with Mr. Iovine's attorney a settlement was reached. The settlement is that all 6 violations will receive a fine of \$5700.00, provided that there are no violations within a year against Mr. Iovine, an additional \$5700.00 will be suspended. If there are any violations then the \$5700.00 payment would become due. Within 3 months the corporation must provide letters that all work was done and inspected properly with no violations. The Attorney and Mr. Iovine agree they will not work in Rhode Island again. A motion to recommend the proposal to the Director of Labor was made by Frank Benell and seconded by Stanley Davies. Passed unanimously by the board.

L. D. Kilkenny Electric fined for doing work in Rhode Island without proper licenses, has paid the fine of \$2000.00 for the company, and \$1000.00 for the employees. The company has put Mr. Frederick Hoesmer as a corporate officer and license holder. Mr. Hoesmer addressed the board on what his responsibilities will be as the corporate license holder. The board requested copies of the completed work that L.D.Kilkenny has already done prior to the issuance of the corporate license.

Glenn Dusablon presented three (3) applications for exam to be reviewed by the board.
