Hearings:

1) Daniel Sullivan - #3820. The city of East Providence asked for a postponement.

Al Durand made a motion to continue viol. #3820 for next meeting seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the board.

2) Henry Thein Nguyen-viol#3873-All parties sworn in, Bob Gaj, Chief Telecom Investigator sworn in as a witness. Glenn Dusablon read the violation: Robert Gaj, Chief Telecommunication Investigator performed an inspection at Queen Nails and Spa, Route 44, Smithfield, RI and found Henry T. Nguyen had contracted electrical sign work in RI without a RI electrical sign contractors license, this is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”, one violation at \$500.00 and also Mr. Nguyen did not obtain an electrical permit with the Town of Smithfield, this is a violation of RIGL 5-6-25-“failure to comply with the requirements of city, town or state”, one violation at \$950.00 for a total of \$1450.00. Bob Gaj addressed the board. The board questioned Mr. Gaj. The board also questioned Mr. Nguyen. Keith Burlingame made a motion that viol #3873 did occur, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the board. Al Durand made a motion that the fine of \$500.00 for RIGL 5-6-2 be upheld, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the board. Al Durand made a motion that the fine of \$950.00 for RIGL 5-6-25 be upheld, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the board.

End of hearing.

A motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting was made by Al Durand and seconded by Bob Zuba. Passed unanimously by the board.

A motion to adjourn was made by Keith Burlingame and seconded by Al Durand. Passed unanimously by the board.
