Hearings:

1) Benjamin Baptista-viol #3933-Mr. Baptista and Glenn Dusablon are sworn in. Glenn Dusablon read the violation: Location of violation: Stillwater Mill, Main Street, Harrisville, RI, Glenn Dusablon, Chief Electrical Investigator performed the investigation and found that Mr.

Benjamin Baptista (A-003150) had an unlicensed employee, Timothy Miller, performing the installation of electrical apparatus without a RI electrical license, this is a violation of RIGL-5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”. For a fine of \$950.00, this is Mr. Baptista third offense. The board questioned Mr. Dusablon. Mr. Baptista addressed the board. The board questioned Mr. Baptista. Keith Burlingame made a motion that viol #3933 did occur seconded by Stan Davies. Passed unanimously by the board. 2) Northern Lights Electrical, Nicholas McCourt-viol#3919-All parties are sworn in. Glenn Dusablon read the violation: On April 29, 2010, Robert Gaj, Chief Telecommunications Investigator performed an investigation at Old Navy, 400 Bald Hill Road, Warwick, RI and found Jason D. Mienscow, Mass license #12025B and Samuel Reynolds, employees of Nicholas McCourt (A-004167), Northern Lights Electric, 218 Park Street, North Attleboro, MA performing electrical work without a Rhode Island electrical license. This is two (2) violations of RIGL 5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”. The first fine of \$500.00 and the consecutive fine of \$950.00 for a total of \$1450.00. Robert Gaj, Chief Telecommunication Investigator addressed the board. The board questioned Mr. Gaj. Nicholas McCourt addressed the board. The board questioned Mr. McCourt. Stan Davies made a motion that violation #3919 did occur seconded by Keith Burlingame. Passed unanimously by the board. Keith Burlingame made a motion

that the fine of \$1450.00 be reduced to \$500.00, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the board.

3) Samuel J. Reynolds-violation #3921. Glen Dusablon read the violation: On April 29, 2010 Robert Gaj, Chief Telecommunications Investigator performed an investigation at Old Navy, 400 Bald Hill Road, Warwick, RI and found Samuel J. Reynolds an employee of Nicholas McCourt, Northern Lights Electric, 218 Park Street, North Attleboro, MA performing electrical work without a RI electrical license. This is a violation of RIGL 5-6-2-“work for which a license is required”. For a fine of \$500.00. Bob Gaj addressed the board. Samuel Reynolds addressed the board. The board questioned Mr. Reynolds. Stan Davis made a motion that violation #3921 did occur, seconded by Keith Burlingame. Passed unanimously by the board. Keith Burlingame made a motion that the fine of \$500.00 be upheld, seconded by Frank Benell. Passed unanimously by the board.
