1.) Call to Order: William Lepore, Jr, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:38am.

2.) Revised minutes of the July 21, 2015 Meeting and 3.) Minutes of the October 21, 2015 meeting: Stanley Davies made a motion to accept the revised minutes of the July 15, 2015 meeting and the minutes of the October 21, 2015 meeting; seconded by Michael Daley.

There is discussion. Vote - In Favor (3): Daley, Davies, Zuba; Opposed (1): Burlingame. Motion carries.

4.) Conflict of Interest – Legal Counsel will address the Board concerning compliance with conflict of interest requirements: Valentino Lombardi, DLT Senior Legal Counsel, reminds board members that they are subject to the RI conflict of interest laws and of their responsibility to disclose conflicts of interest, financial or otherwise, and should recuse from discussion and voting on the matter.

6.) Revocation / Suspension Hearings:

Scott Fernandes – B-014019 (Violation 4905): The revocation / suspension hearing is for unpaid fines of \$500.00 assessed with Violation 4905. Glenn Dusablon, DLT Chief Electrical Investigator; and Scott Fernandes are sworn in for testimony.

Glenn Dusablon reads the Violation 4905 into the record, provides testimony and is questioned by the Board.

Scott Fernandes provides testimony and is questioned by the Board.

Michael Daley made a motion to table the revocation / suspension of the license pending accommodations be made with the Department for a payment plan; seconded by Robert Zuba. There is discussion. Mr. Lepore recommends the fine be paid by the next meeting and Mr. Fernandes come to the next meeting to close out the hearing. Mr. Daley agreed to the amendment. All were in favor.

Michael Moran – B-010152 (Violation 4765): Michael Moran does not appear. Glenn Dusablon reads the Violation 4765 into the record. Mr. Dusablon confirms Mr. Moran was sent notice for the hearing by certified and regular mail.

Michael Daley made a motion that the license of Michael Moran, B-010152, be revoked; seconded by Robert Zuba; and passed unanimously by the Board.

The recommendation will be forwarded to the Department.

7.) State of New Hampshire requests the Board to consider a

reciprocal license agreement: There is discussion.

Michael Daley made a motion to deny the request; seconded by Robert Zuba and passed unanimously by the Board.

8.) Trade Source - Discussion: Glenn Dusablon addressed the Board. Information has been received and the Department is going forward with the violation.

9.) Adjournment: A motion to adjourn was made by Michael Daley; seconded by Robert Zuba. All were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 10:04am.
