Notice is hereby given that the State Workforce Investment Office of the RI Department of Labor and Training will hold a public hearing on Monday, April 16, 2007 from 10:00 AM to Noon at the RI Department of Labor and Training, 1511 Pontiac Avenue, Building 73, 1st Floor Conference Room, Cranston, RI to solicit comments from interested parties regarding the proposed amendment to the Two-Year State Workforce Plan for the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.

The Governor's Workforce Board RI, legislated under the federal Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998, administers workforce investment services for all Rhode Island cities and towns. The Two-Year Plan describes the state's workforce investment strategies related to services for adults, dislocated workers, youth and employers.
